God shows no partiality." Acts 10:34**

The earliest Christians were mostly Jews. In general, they mistrusted Gentiles. Their mistrust was rooted in their history. These first Christians believed their Jesus had come only for them. They believed there was no room for Gentiles in their new religious community—unless they first became Jews. Peter fought against this mentality, saying that Jesus came for Jews and Gentiles. In fact, Jesus came for all. No exclusions.

Today might be a good day to reflect on those individuals whom we don't like, those whom we tend to exclude from the circle of our love and respect—perhaps people of a particular race, gender, age, ethnic origin, sexual orientation, occupation, or economic status.

In the words of today's responsorial psalm, Jesus came and sang "a new song," a song that calls his followers to widen the circle of their love "to the ends of the earth."

Jesus, help me to widen the circle of my love and care—especially to include_____.

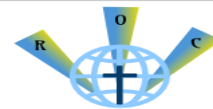
